The council meeting minutes were agreed and they were signed by the Chairman as a true record of the meeting.

3.1. Matters arising from the minutes

1. Cllr Husband confirmed that the two large caravans parked up on Sweyns Lease, which were causing concern, have now been removed, a small caravan is now sited at the property.
2. Cllr Husband has contacted Steven Harris from Open Reach about ongoing broadband issues in East Boldre, he is waiting to hear back. The parish council will contact Julian Lewis and ask if it would be possible to organise a meeting for Natural England, the Verderers, Cllr Mans, Glen Peacy and Open Reach, in order to establish a constructive plan and a way forward for the installation of broadband in the village.
3. Cllr Hawker reported that the allotment management is now working well. All tenants have now returned their tenancy agreements ensuring that they are all members of NSALG and East Boldre Allotment Association. This is necessary for allotment insurance cover.

The clerk also sought advice on the matter from both HALC and the monitoring officer at NFDC, who are happy that the council followed all the correct procedures on this matter.
