The council has sadly been plagued by consistent low petty criminal damage over the past few months. Things have not improved during the Covid 19 Crisis and the community police are now making East Boldre one of their priorities for there work.

Community police officers need clear video evidence in order to convict anyone for the criminal damage in the village. They have requested that the parish council purchase day/night CCTV cameras for various locations in the village. They are happy to offer advice on how and where to install the cameras.

The clerk has been approached by NFNPA who will offer 50% grant for new village signs. The council has already commissioned a replacement of the broken sign – NFNPA is

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offering to pay for 50% of this and 50% of the cost of a new matching sign at the far end of the village.
